# Hazard Communication Program

### A. Company Policy

Geaux Polish LLC is committed to the prevention of exposures that result in injury and/or illness; and to comply with all applicable state health and safety rules. To make sure that all affected employees know about information concerning the dangers of all hazardous chemicals used by dental facilities, the following hazard communication program has been established. ## **B.** Container Labeling

Dental facilities are responsible for container labeling procedures, reviewing, and updating. The labeling system used at different dental facilities will vary.

# C. Safety Data Sheets (SDS)

Dental facilities are responsible for establishing and monitoring SDS programs, as well as making sure procedures are developed to obtain the necessary SDSs, and review incoming SDSs for new or significant health and safety information.

Copies of SDSs for all hazardous chemicals in use will be kept in a specific location according to each dental facility. SDSs should be available to all employees during each work shift. If an SDS is not available or a new chemical in use does not have an SDS, immediately contact: the doctor or manager of that facility and Geaux Polish.

## D. Employee Information and Training

Geaux Polish is responsible for the employee training program of Geaux Polish employees. The procedures for how employees will be informed and trained are as follows:

- training will be provided by Geaux Polish through MedSafe and required to complete online upon hiring and every year thereafter;
- employees may inquire of any dental facility for specific site training.

Geaux Polish will make sure that before starting work, each new employee will complete a 2 hr continuing education course on OSHA.
